#### 1st Quarter Clubs:

Craft Club (all grades) with Mr. Jon: Mondays (Aug. 26th - Oct. 14th)
\*No club on 9/2 due to Labor Day, club will run on Friday, 9/6 that week\*

- Maximum enrollment 15
- Students will have the opportunity to learn a variety of new and useful crafts that they

  will nurture your child's creative mind while having fun in the process!

- Holiday Kitchen Club (all grades) w/ Ms. Carole Ann: Tuesdays (Oct. 22nd Dec. 17th)
  - Maximum enrollment 12
